We are very excited to announce that the **Tree Currency Program** will begin in Chauffard on July 1, 2024. This proven program brings an agronomist to the village who will set up five large tree nurseries. In exchange for working in the nurseries, 400 local farmers will receive tools, training and seeds to help them improve yields on their own farming plots. As the trees grow, the farmers will plant the seedlings, helping to stabilize their land. Eventually, the trees will provide fruit for their families to eat and sell.
